SAVE THE DATE - FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2017 - FULL SCALE EMERGENCY EVACUATION DRILL

This year on Friday, April 21, 2017 our entire school population will engage in a Full Scale Emergency Evacuation Drill. Each year our school, in accordance with Ministry of Education guidelines, conducts regular Fire, Earthquake and Lockdown drills. However, during this special drill, staff and students will extend the practice by:

- Grouping our student population into pre-determined “Colour Groups”,
- Taking out our emergency “Comfort Kits” (kits that contain food, a blanket, and other necessities),
- Setting up Command and Release Posts
- Sending home students from the Release Post

In order to facilitate the smooth operation of this drill, **we are asking for parents to start picking up their child(ren) from 2:00 pm onwards on Friday, April 21, 2017**. Please note that this process will take time as each child will have to be signed out from our “Release Post” (which will be located by the “Blue gate” adjacent to the priests’ rectory). Patience and understanding will be needed as we engage in this necessary drill for the first time. Below is a list of *Parent Responsibilities* that will need to be adhered to during this time. Full Scale Emergency Evacuation Drill

Parents - Description of Roles and Responsibilities

After an earthquake, fire, or any emergency requiring evacuation of the school, these procedures should be followed:

DO NOT attempt to phone the school. If the phone lines are open, they may be needed for emergencies.

When you (or an alternate caregiver) arrive at the school to pick up children, you will find them assembled in the playground or in the school.

If on the playground, you must report to the Release Station at the blue gate (next to the rectory).

If we have re-entered the school, report to the Release Station in the front entrance of the school (lobby).

BE PATIENT AND CALM - RELEASING STUDENTS WILL TAKE TIME. WE WILL ALL BE ANXIOUS AND IF WE WORK TOGETHER EVERYONE WILL BE SAFE.

When we get to the Release Station, report (one at a time) to Ms. Patrizia Rossi or Mrs. Linda Potter. They will send a runner to bring your child(ren) to you.

PARENTS WILL NOT ENTER THE BLUE GATE UNLESS THEIR CHILD IS INJURED.

In the case of an injured child, the parent will be taken to that child. Your other children will stay in their team assembly area until you are ready to leave.

When your child is brought to the Release Station, Ms. Patrizia Rossi or Mrs. Linda Potter will have you sign a Master Release Form and then you may be on your way.

REMINDER - LENTEN MASSES

During the season of Lent we ask students in Grades 3 - 7 to make an extra effort to attend 8:00 am morning Mass at St. Matthew's. Students are asked to arrive at the church no later than 7:55 am and meet their teacher and classmates. Below is a schedule of the Masses:
