## 6) Pastor's Report (Fr. Tran)

- Father commends the school for a having a good Christmas concert.
- He would like to work on the scheduling for next year's concert to avoid schedule conflicts in the sanctuary.

- With New Years Day falling on a Sunday he observed how many people attended Mass.
- He is concerned about the snow and ice removal of our schools and parish parking lot. There had been miscommunication with the snow and ice removal company so he had to hire another contractor. Parishioner Richard Thompson used his equipment to salt the lot. We are fortunate to have him in our community.
- The snow removal bill has been substantial.
- The building project to a build the plaza is dealing with an issue regarding property lines. Father is working with the City and the RCVA to resolve this.
- Father announced that HC is planning to build special portables at the back of their school and use the road behind them to smooth traffic.
- Father reminded us that he will be away for a month on mission and vacation in Vietnam starting January 23.
